## **Job Posting for Teacher/Animator**

### **Our Organization:**

CHIP (Communicaid for Hearing Impaired Persons) is a nonprofit organization serving the English-speaking hard-of-hearing community in Montreal. This Fall, CHIP has partnered with The Hearing Foundation of Canada to bring the Sound Sense program to Montreal schools as part of our HEAR-ENTENDRE program. HEAR-ENTENDRE, the only bilingual program of its kind in Quebec, aims to promote awareness about Noise-Induced Hearing Loss (NIHL): permanent hearing loss resulting from unprotected, repeated, and prolonged exposure to loud sounds.

### **The Position:**

CHIP is seeking part-time animators to present HEAR-ENTENDRE in Montreal-area elementary schools.

Presentations will last one hour and weekly schedules will vary depending on registration. This is a part-time, contract position.

### **Responsibilities and Requirements:**

Animators will be responsible for arranging travel to and from schools including transporting program materials, communicating with school staff on arrival, setting up and delivering presentations, and completing follow-up paperwork and evaluations.

Animators must be comfortable presenting in English OR French; our office is a primarily English-language environment.

Candidates must have previous experience working with elementary-aged children and have strong presentation and group-management skills.

### **Hourly Rate:**

Competitive, based on experience.
