We understand and are concerned with the struggles and the difficulties that people with hearing difficulties often experience in their daily lives.

Hear Entendre Québec's mandate is not only to offer ongoing programs and services but also to connect and inspire those affected by hearing loss, thereby helping to improve the quality of life and counter isolation. The various programs help to raise awareness about the potential consequences of hearing loss, such as isolation, depression, anger, and dementia, to name a few. As a largely "invisible" disability, there are many "myths" and misconceptions about hearing loss. Our vision is a community where we can hear, be heard and thrive.
